

# Animation Camp

Register TODAY for a fun and engaging hands-on filmmaking opportunity for youth over 13 at the Multicultural Cinema Club at The Working Centre.



Five unique one-day sessions from August 11<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>, from 1:00 to 5:00 PM each day.

Learn, explore your creativity, and work in groups to create your very own animated projects in a hands-on, dynamic, and interactive setting.

## Day 1: Animation Basics

Create characters. Develop story ideas. Make storyboards. Go over how to make a puppet. Start making puppet. Finish class by making a 'Bouncing Ball' animation with the group.

## Day 2: Character Design & Animation

Review storyboards. Mold making demonstration. Go over animation principals such as Squash & Stretch. Finish puppets. Animate puppets blinking, waving arms, & walking.

## Day 3: Talking Tutorial & Talking Animation

Simple puppet talking tutorial. Record short dialogue. Draw & cut out mouth shapes for talking test. Plan, create, & animate simple dialogue. More animation tests if time allows.

## Day 4: Review Final Animation & Begin Filming Final Animation

Review and revise final animation projects. Start animating final projects.

## Day 5: Complete Final Animation & Add Sound

Finish animating final project. Compile & Edit final project. Add titles, and sound to final project.



Each student will receive a DVD with their animation(s) on it the week after the class!
